Brief Outline of the Symposium :

Maturation phenomenon, first described by Ito et al.,* has been defined as development of changes with different time of appearance in individual parameters of ischemic injury, and with general principle that the length of delay in onset of these changes during the postischemic period is directly related to intensity of ischemic insults. A delayed neuronal death of CA 1 pyramidal cells in the hippocampus has been a classic example of maturation phenomenon and majority of investigations have been centered on this area. It has been recently becoming apparent that delayed ischemic changes of chronic character may develop in many other neuronal locations outside of hippocampus and even in areas unaffected directly by ischemia.

The main object of this symposium is to elucidate the nature and basic mechanisms operating in maturation phenomenon. Assuming that the chronically "ill-but-not-dead" neurons may be still amendable to treatment and recovery, rationalities and possibilities of therapeutic manipulation in conditions associated with chronic ischemic injury will be evaluated and discussed.
